

ACROSS THE MOUNTAINS.

PROPOSED FLIGHT BY M. GUILLAUX.

SYDNEY. Friday.

M. Guillaux, the French aviator, has decided to make several long-distance flights in Australia in the course of the next couple of months. The first will probably be from Sydney to Newcastle and back, the second and third from Sydney to Melbourne, and from Melbourne to Sydney, and the fourth across the Blue Mountains. On each flight the aviator will be accompanied by a passenger, who, in one or two cases, will be Mr. Hordern.

M. Guillaux stated that, in response to a number of requests, he had definitely decided to open an aviation school in Sydney. He would make a start, he added, about three months hence, by which time he expected that a hydro-aeroplane, monoplane, and biplane, which he had ordered, would have arrived.
