FLIGHT IN BATHURST.

Mr. R. H. Treacy, of Messrs. MacCallum Bros. and Treacy, Australian managers for M. Maurice Guillaux, the famous French aviator, will be in Bathurst to-day, and if suitable arrangements can be made for a ground M. Guillaux will give an aerial exhibition, which will be his final appearance in Australia. In addition to "looping the loop" he will go through a series of sensational aerial manoeuvres never before attempted in the history of aviation, and will demonstrate the usefulness of the aeroplane in warfare by dropping bombs on objects placed on the ground.
