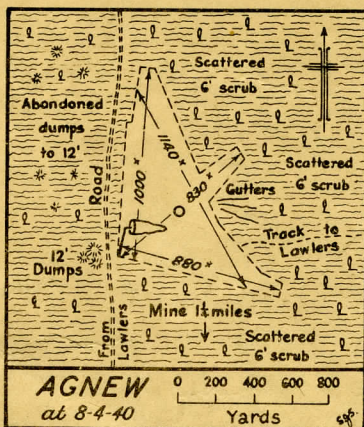
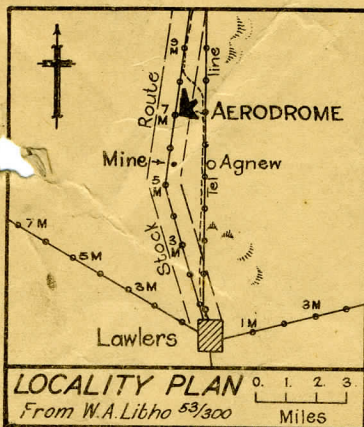

LATITUDE: 27° 59' S; LONGITUDE: 120° 30' E; MAG. VAR: 0 1/2° West.

ALTITUDE: 1,400 feet approx.

POSITION: Approx. 7 miles north of Lawlers township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.4.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough and rocky, scrub 6 ft. high, and scattered mining dumps.

LANDMARKS: Mine approx. 1 1/2 miles south. Telegraph line and road to east. Road and mining dumps along western side.

APPROACHES: Generally over scrub 6 ft. high. Smoke stack of mine 1 1/2 miles south.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: From 800 yards to 1,140 yards (see sketch).

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Lawlers, 7 miles south.

RAILWAY STATION: Leonora, 80 miles SE.

TELEPHONE: Lawlers Post Office.

HANGAR: Nil.

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Limited resources at mine 1 1/2 miles south.

WATER: At mine.

PROPRIETORS: Leonora Road Board, Leonora, W.A.

CHARGES: 2/- per landing, 10/- per day.
