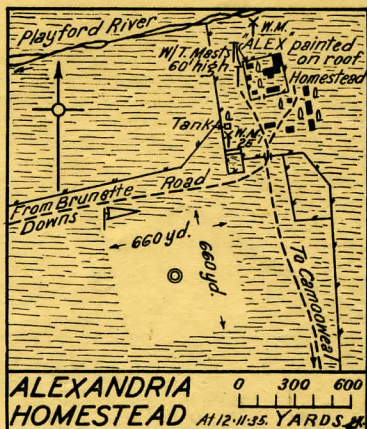

NOTICE TO AIRMEN NO. 13/1936.
 ("DRY WEATHER") **ALEXANDRIA HOMESTEAD, N.T.**



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes in dry weather only.

PROPRIETOR: C.A.Y. Johnston, Esq., Alexandria Station, N.T.

POSITION: Immediately S.W. of Alexandria homestead.

Lat. $19^{\circ} 2\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $136^{\circ} 42'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Homestead buildings and stockyards immediately N.E.

The letters "ALEX" are painted on the roof of the W/T hut.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Black soil, suitable in dry weather only.

DIMENSIONS: 660 yards square.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 800 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: W/T masts 60 ft. high, windmills and buildings to N.E. Remainder clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Principally open black soil plains, except to the north and west.

PETROL AND OIL: Limited supplies at homestead.

WATER SUPPLY: Homestead.

WORKSHOPS: Homestead garage.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Wireless station at homestead.

NEAREST TOWN: Carnoolan, 150 miles by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Mt. Isa, 250 miles by road.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: This ground is not suitable in wet weather. Government all-weather ground $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.N.W. on edge of timbered hills. (See Notice to Airmen No. 45/1932).
