



ARRINO, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, licensed for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETOR: A.F.N. Sheppard, Esq., Centenary House, Dudawa, via Arrino Midland Railway, W.A.

POSITION: About 5 miles N.E. of Arrino railway station.

Lat. 29° 25' S. Long. 115° 35' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 3½° W. approx.

LANDMARKS: Road along western boundary; dams near boundary to north; road and tel. line about ½ mile south; farm at N.W. corner.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator; well (S.W.) and watercourse (east) marked off by white tins.

SURFACE: Generally good level surface, S.E. sector (see plan) likely to be bad during wet weather.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 700 yards.

E. - W. 590 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 860 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North, over scattered trees to 15 ft. high; south, tel. line 18 ft. high ½ mile distant, then clear, cultivated land; east, trees to 30 ft. high; west, over hill 20 ft. high about ½ mile distant, and road.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Level, cultivated, with some timber in patches.

PETROL AND OIL: At Arrino, 5 miles S.W.

WATER SUPPLY: Farm adjoining aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Garage, Arrino.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Dudawa, 2 miles east.

NEAREST TOWN: Arrino.

RAILWAY STATION: Arrino.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: Relative Strip Map No. 53.
