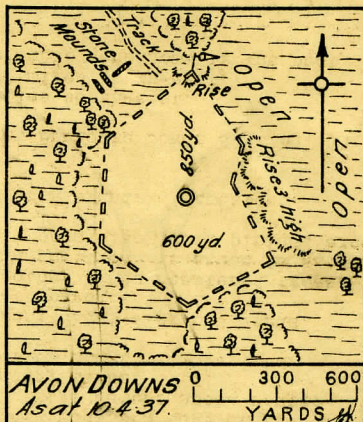
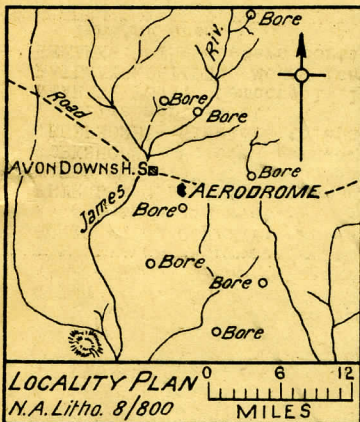


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

AVON DOWNS, N.T.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: The Peel River Land and Mineral Co. Ltd.

(J.W. Spratt, Manager), Avon Downs Station, via Camooweal, Qld.

POSITION: About 2 miles E.S.E. of Avon Downs Homestead.

48 miles west of Camooweal.

Lat: $20^{\circ} 03' S$; Long: $137^{\circ} 30' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Irregular diamond shaped ground situated at south end of large red soil patch, S.E. of homestead. Distinct lines of heaped stones 100 yards from N.W. boundary.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks and wind indicator.

"AVON" painted on roof of one of homestead outbuildings.

SURFACE: Good all weather surface.

DIMENSIONS: North-south 850 yards; East-west 600 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 700 feet approx.

APPROACHES: Patches of timber on north, west and south.

Otherwise open.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open plains with patches of red soil suitable for forced landings.

PETROL & OIL: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.

WORKSHOPS: At homestead.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: At homestead.

NEAREST TOWN: Camooweal, 48 miles east.

RAILWAY STATION: Mount Isa, 190 miles south-east.

REMARKS: Stripmap No. 6.
