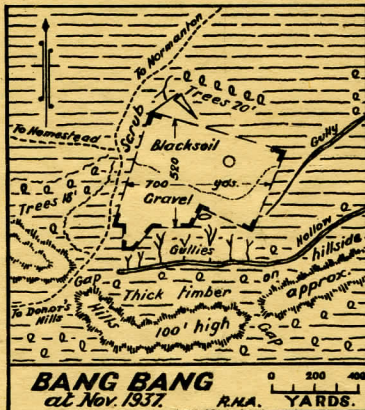
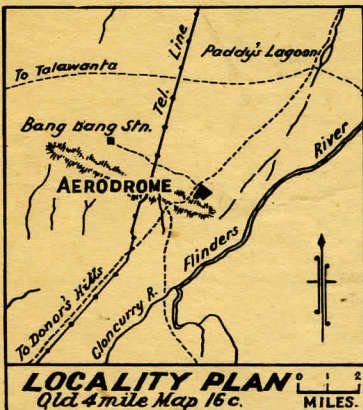

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types except large multi-engined landplanes.
 PROPRIETOR: W.Clark, Esq., Bang Bang Station, via Normanton, Qld.
 POSITION: About $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles south-east of homestead.
 Lat: $18^{\circ} 32'$ S. Long: $140^{\circ} 40'$ E.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.
 LANDMARKS: Flinders River to the east, range of hills on the south, and Cloncurry-Normanton telephone line to west.
 MARKINGS: White circle, boundary markings and wind indicator.
 SURFACE: Level, red gravel on southern half, black soil on northern. Southern portion suitable in all weather.
 DIMENSIONS: N-S: 520 yards. E-W: 700 yards.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 200 ft. approx.
 APPROACHES: North and east, clear; south, over hills 100 ft. high; west, over trees and scrub.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: North, east and west are open plains with scattered timber. South, hilly and timbered.
 PETROL & OIL: Limited supply at homestead.
 WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.
 WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith shop at homestead.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
 TELEPHONE: Homestead.
 NEAREST POST OFFICE: Donnor's Hills, 18 miles SSW.
 NEAREST TOWN: Normanton, 70 miles NNE.
 NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Dobbyn, 96 miles SSW.
 CHARGES: Nil at present.
 REMARKS: Northern black soil half of aerodrome is not suitable for use during wet weather. Relative Stripmap No.29.
