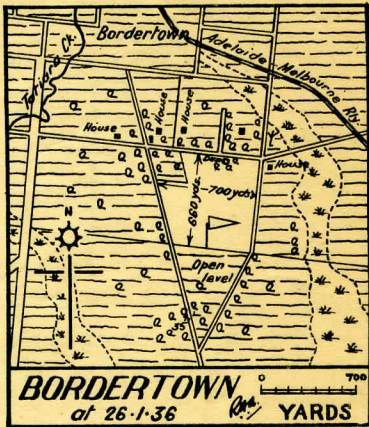
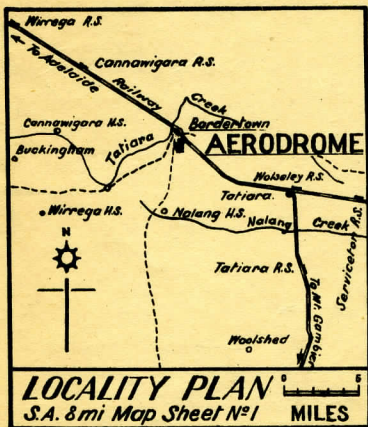

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.  
 PROPRIETORS: District Council of Tatiara, Box 24, Bordertown.  
 POSITION: About a mile S.E. of Bordertown.  
 Lat.  $36^{\circ} 19' S$ . Long.  $140^{\circ} 46' E$ .  
 MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $7^{\circ} E$ . approx.  
 LANDMARKS: Melbourne-Adelaide railway and Tatiara Creek. Dam near the northern boundary.  
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.  
 SURFACE: Grassed, sandy soil, undulating, falling generally towards the north.  
 DIMENSIONS: North - south 660 yards.  
 East - west 700 "  
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 400 ft. approx.  
 APPROACHES: Scattered trees along west and north boundaries.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Small cultivated paddocks with scattered timber all around.  
 PETROL AND OIL: Bordertown.  
 WATER SUPPLY: Houses nearby.  
 WORKSHOPS: Bordertown.  
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
 TELEPHONE: At house near aerodrome.  
 TELEGRAPH: Post Office, Bordertown.  
 NEAREST TOWN: Bordertown, about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles by good road.  
 NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Bordertown.  
 CHARGES: Nil at present.  
 REMARKS: Strip map No. 5.
