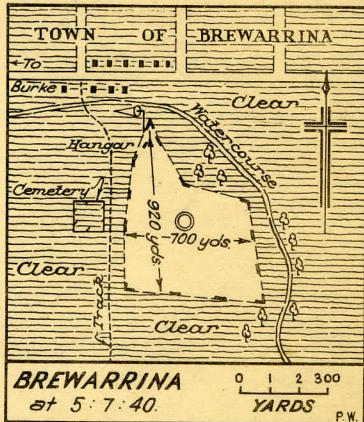
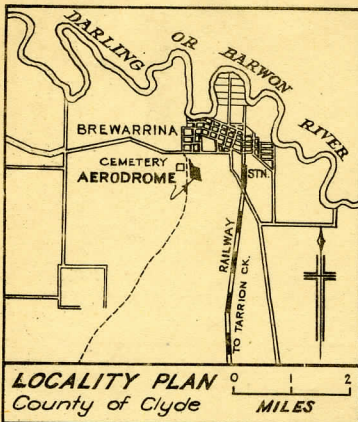

LATITUDE: 29°58' S. LONGITUDE: 146°51' E. MAG. VAR: 8° E. approx.
ALTITUDE: 350 feet approx.

POSITION: SW of town of Brewarrina, and about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile W of Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H.8. Stripmap No.31.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scattered timber and open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Town of Brewarrina to NE; cemetery and track immediately W and watercourse to N and E.

APPROACHES: Clear except for few scattered trees.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 920 yards; E-W, 700 yards.

SURFACE: Fair - sticky after rain.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Brewarrina, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles NE.

TELEPHONE: Brewarrina.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Brewarrina.

WATER: Brewarrina.

PROPRIETORS: The Brewarrina Municipal Council, Brewarrina, N.S.W.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
