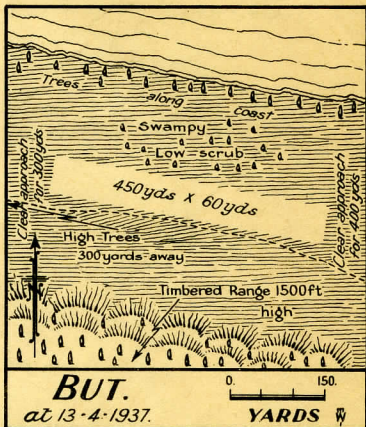


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, suitable for single and light multi-engined landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Administration of the Territory of New Guinea.

POSITION: On the coast about 30 miles North-West of Wewak.

Lat.: 3° 22' S.; Long.: 143° 17' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 5½° East approx.

LANDMARKS: Sea coast to the North, high mountains South.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Firm level surface, good in all weather.

DIMENSIONS: Single strip 450 yards long by 60 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 20 feet approx.

APPROACHES: From East - over scattered trees then clear for 400 yards; from West - over high trees then clear for 300 yards.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountainous.

PETROL AND OIL: Limited supply at Wom aerodrome about 25 miles South-East.

WATER SUPPLY: Nearby creeks.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION & WORKSHOPS: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Wewak Radio, 30 miles South-East.

NEAREST SETTLEMENT and SEAPORT: Wewak.

CHARGES: Nil.
