

POSITION: About 3 miles north of Griffith township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet J. 8. Stripmaps Nos. 31,73. SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Irrigation areas and timber.

LANDMARKS: Lake View branch canal along NW boundary and town-

ship of Griffith 3 miles south. APPROACHES: NW - orchards and overhead lines 20 ft. high. NE - timber 30 ft. high. SE - over stumps and timber 30 ft. high. SW - timber 30 ft. high.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator, white circle and white drums at cor-

ners. DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 830 yds. NW-SE, 550 yds. W by S-E by N, 940 yds.

SURFACE: Loam surface, should be good in all weathers.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Griffith, 3 miles south.

TELEPHONE: House, 4 mile from aerodrome (Mr.J.G. Casserly, No. 169).

HANGARS: Nil. REPAIRS: Griffith garages. REFUELLING: Griffith.

WATER: At house nearby.

PROPRIETORS: Wade Shire Council, Banna Avenue, Griffith, N.S.W. CHARGES: Nil at present.
