

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open and rough, unsuitable for forced landing.

LANDMARKS: Knob Town about 1½ miles west, railway line immediately south; lams at north-west corner.

APPROACHES: Railway and power line (48 ft. high) immediately to south and south-west; dams (10 ft. high) and tel.line 20 ft. high near north-west corner; otherwise open.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks and wind indicator. DIMENSIONS: N-S, 880 yards. E-W, 770 yards. SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION; Iron Knob, 12 miles north-west. TELEPHONE: At aerodrome.

HANGARS: REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Iron Knob. WATER: At dams adjacent.
