

LATITUDE: 26° 35' S; LONGITUDE: 151° 51' E; MAG. VAR: 8½° E app. ALTITUDE: 1,400 feet approx.

POSITION: About 3 miles south of Kingaroy township.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and generally timbered, but with

many open cultivation paddocks.

LANDMARKS: Taabinga Railway Station to west of ground.

Kingaroy township 3 miles north.

APPROACHES: N - few scattered trees. E - clear. S - tel.line end few trees. W - tel.line, house, sheds, and railway line.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator, and tops of fences and telephone hut painted white.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1,000 yds. E-W, 990 yds. NE-SW, 900 yds. NW-SE, 1,200 yds.

SURFACE: Graded strips good.

TOWN: Kingaroy, 3 miles north.
RAILWAY STATION: Taabinga siding, adjacent to west.
TELEPHONE: At Store, ½ mile south from entrance gate.

HANGARS: Nil. REPAIRS: Kingaroy.

REFUELLING: On ground by arrangement only. WATER: At nearby house. Windmill on ground.

PROPRIETORS: Shire of Kingaroy, P.O.Box 172, Kingaroy, Qld. CHARGES: 1-2 seater planes - 2/6 per landing, or 10/- per day. 3-4 - 5/-" 15/-Over 6 - 10/- " 40/-

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots should note that during squally weather the wind is likely to be somewhat erratic and veering easterly.
