

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single and light multiengined landplanes.

Mr. M.B. Chapman, C/o Mr. A.E. Zeitz, Kingscote, PROPRIETOR: Kangaroo I., S.A.

POSITION: 14 miles W.S.W. of Kingscote. Lat. 35° 38½' S. Long. 137° 38' E. MAGNETIC VARIATION: 5° E. approx.

Main road and telegraph line near southern boundary. LANDMARKS: Town of Kingscote 14 miles E.N.E.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Undulating falling generally to south. Narrow belt of scrub projects into the landing area from northern boundary. DIMENSIONS: N.N.W.-S.S.E. 660 yards; E.N.E.-W.S.W. 700 yards. HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 100 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North, line of scrub 25 ft. high along disused road on rising ground; south, tel. line 30 ft. high along main road on falling ground; east, open except for line of trees on falling ground; west, open.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open, undulating paddocks suitable for

forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Kingscote. WATER SUPPLY: Tanks near ground.

WORKSHOPS: Kingscote garages.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
