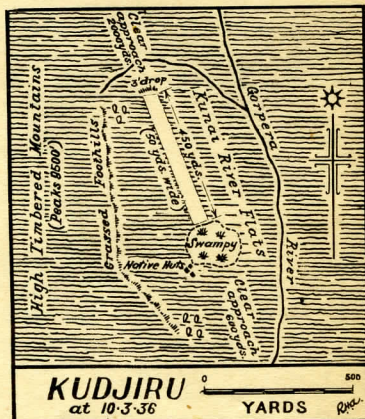
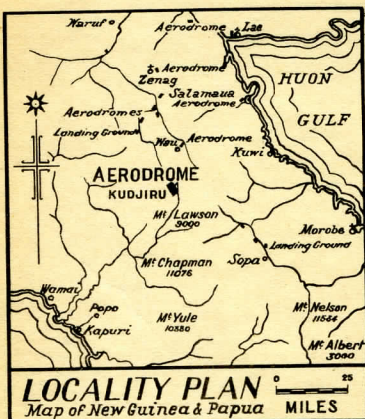


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
 PROPRIETORS: The Administration, Territory of New Guinea.
 POSITION: About 12 miles south of Wau, on the west bank of the Gorpera River. Lat. $7^{\circ} 32' S$. Long. $146^{\circ} 42' E$.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6^{\circ} E$. approx.
 LANDMARKS: Gorpera River. Native huts at south end of ground.
 MARKINGS: Nil.
 SURFACE: Grass surface on open river flats.
 DIMENSIONS: 450 yards long, 50 yards wide.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 6,150 ft.
 APPROACHES: North - clear grass country for 2,000 yards.
 South - clear for 600 yards with small patch of swampy ground at south end of ground.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rugged timbered mountains, not suitable for forced landings.
 PETROL AND OIL: Nil.
 WATER SUPPLY: Gorpera River.
 WORKSHOPS: Nil.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
 TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Radio at Wau.
 NEAREST TOWN: Wau, about 12 miles north.
 CHARGES: Nil.
 REMARKS: Ground soft after heavy rain.
