

LATITUDE: 28° 53' S; LONGITUDE: 121° 18½' E; MAG.VAR: ½° W app. ALTITUDE: 1,230 feet approx.

POSITION: About 1½ miles NNW of Town of Leomora.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.4.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally covered with light scrub. When dry, lake beds are suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Aerodrome is portion of racecourse. Grandstand on western boundary; cemetery on west side of southern leg.

APPROACHES: West - grandstand 30 ft. high with two 10 ft.poles on roof. Remainder - scrub 8 ft. high.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: North-south, 830 yds; North-west, South-east - 940 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Leonora, 1 miles SSE.
TELEPHONE: Leonora.
HANGARS: Nil.
REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Leonora.
WATER: Leonora.

PROPRIETORS: Leonora Road Board, Leonora, W.A. CHARGES: 2/6 per landing or 10/- per day.

SPECIAL REMARKS: The surface may be soft after rain.
