

ALTITUDE: 40 feet approx.

POSITION: About three miles south of Lismore township.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.9. Stripmap No.2.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating pasture land, with dead trees and stumps. Range of hills approx. 400 ft. high, about 1 mile to north-east.

LANDMARKS: North arm of Richmond River runs along western

boundary. Creek along southern boundary.

APPROACHES: North - scattered timber. South - over Creek, low scrub and marked depression and drains. East - scattered dead trees in adjacent paddocks. West - over river, low scrub and marked depression.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. White discs around the depression and drain. "NEW ENGLAND AIRWAYS" on hangar roof.
DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 925 yds. NE-SW, 850 yds.
SURFACE: Fairly level, well grassed, brown sandy loam.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Lismore, three miles north. TELEPHONE: On Aerodrome (Lismore 400). HANGARS: One hangar 40' x 30'. REPAIRS & REFUELLING: On Aerodrome.

WATER: On Aerodrome.
