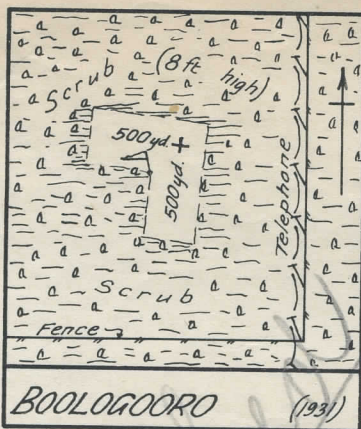


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

BOOLOGOORO, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes, except large multi-engined machines.

PROPRIETOR: H. Campbell Esq., Boologooro Station, via Carnarvon, W.A.

POSITION: About $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of homestead. Roughly 50 miles N.N.E. from Carnarvon.

Lat. $24^{\circ} 27\frac{1}{2}' S$. Long. $114^{\circ} 2' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: An L shaped clearing in scrub.

MARKINGS: Ground mark and wind indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Good level surface, red sandy soil, liable to be soft after heavy rain.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 500 yards.

E. - W. 500 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 200 ft.

APPROACHES: Over scrub 8 feet high in all directions.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timber and scrub, with some open patches.

Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.

WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

TELEGRAPH: Carnarvon Post Office.

NEAREST TOWN: Carnarvon.

NEAREST PORT: Carnarvon.
