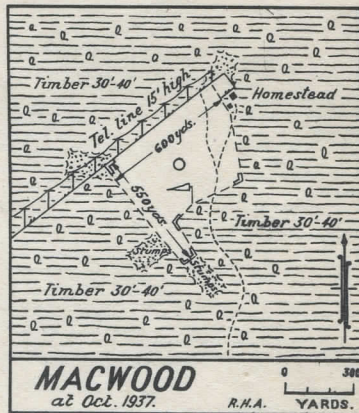
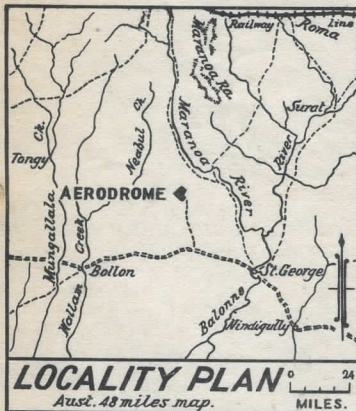


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

MACWOOD, QLD.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of aircraft such as D.H.60 "Moth" etc.

PROPRIETOR: J.F. Jackson, P.O. Box 88, St. George, Qld.

POSITION: At homestead about 62 miles NW of St. George.

Lat: $27^{\circ} 35' S$; Long: $148^{\circ} 6' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $8^{\circ} E$ approx.

LANDMARKS: Macwood homestead alongside.

Another homestead about 2 miles south east.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary markings and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Smooth, level, sandy loam surface; should be suitable in all weather.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE: 550 yards; NE-SW: 600 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 700 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N and NW - timber 30 to 40 ft. high and tel. line 15 ft. high; all other directions - timber 30 to 40 ft. high with felled approaches as shown.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat timbered country not suitable for forced landings.

PETROL & OIL: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER SUPPLY & WORKSHOP: Homestead.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Homestead (N.8 Aqualoo).

NEAREST TOWN & POST OFFICE: St. George, 62 miles south east.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Roma, 90 miles north east.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
