

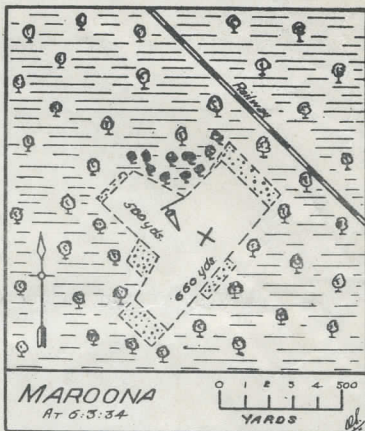
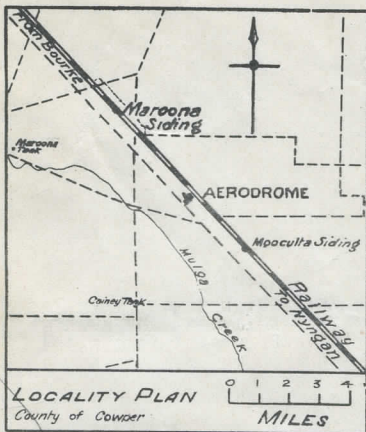

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.  
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia, (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).  
POSITION: 4 miles S.E. of Maroona Siding on S.W. side of Nyngan-Bourke railway.  
Lat.  $30^{\circ}18'S$ . Long.  $146^{\circ}51'E$ .  
MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. approx.  
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Clearing in timber adjoining railway.  
MARKINGS: White Cross and Wind Indicator.  
DESCRIPTION: T-shaped ground with good surface; should be suitable in all weathers.  
DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W. 660 yards.  
N.W. - S.E. 500 yards.  
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 370 ft. approx.  
APPROACHES: Timber on all sides with small areas felled on boundaries as on plan.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, some open plains to the N.W.  
PETROL AND OIL: Bourke, 17 miles N.W. by road.  
WATER SUPPLY: Maroona Siding, 4 miles N.W.  
WORKSHOPS: Bourke.  
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
NEAREST TELEPHONE: Maroona Siding.  
NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Bourke.  
NEAREST TOWN: Bourke, 17 miles N.W. by road.  
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Maroona Siding, 4 miles N.W.
