**I** T is hereby notified that an Emergency Landing Ground has been established at MOORARA, NEW SOUTH WALES.

The following particulars regarding this Emergency Landing Ground are published for information:—

<i>Proprietors</i> .. ..	Commonwealth of Australia, on licence under C.A. Form 22 from Mr. C. Bock, Wicklow, via Pooncarie.
<i>Position</i> .. ..	Latitude 33° 12' S.; longitude 142° 23' E. Situated 18 miles north of Pooncarie on east of Darling River on Pooncarie-Menindie-road.
<i>Distinctive Features</i> ..	Road to east.
<i>Magnetic Variation</i> ..	7° 25' E. (approx.).
<i>Height above Sea Level</i>	About 475 feet.
<i>Description</i> .. ..	L-shaped ground. Surface limestone gravel and red loam. Fair all weathers.
<i>Dimensions for Landing</i>	600 yards east and west; 400 yards north and south.
<i>Markings</i> .. ..	Ground marking (white cross) and wind indicator at angle of L.
<i>Approaches</i> .. ..	North, Mallee 20 feet high. South, timber. East, clear. West, Mallee.
<i>Surrounding Country</i> ..	Mallee; few small clear patches.
<i>Petrol and Oil</i> .. ..	Pooncarie; 18 miles, nearest certain supply. Moorara Station, about 2 miles south, might supply.
<i>Workshops</i> .. ..	None nearer than Wentworth, about 70 miles south-south-west.
<i>Nearest Railway Station</i>	Menindie. (River transport available in season.)
<i>Nearest Town</i> .. ..	Pooncarie, 18 miles.
<i>Nearest Telephone</i> ..	Moorara Homestead.
<i>Nearest Telegraph</i> ..	Pooncarie Post Office.
<i>Water Supply</i> .. ..	Moorara Homestead nearest.
