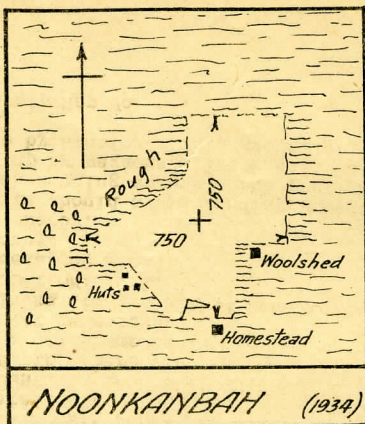


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: Lat.  $18^{\circ}30'S$ . Long.  $124^{\circ}49'E$ .MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $2^{\circ}$  E. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Open ironstone flat immediately in front of homestead.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator on eastern boundary.

DESCRIPTION: Level surface of gravel and ironstone; loamy soil.

Should be firm all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 750 yards.

E. - W. 750 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 400 feet.

APPROACHES: North, clear; East, over woolshed and fences;

South, over homestead; West, timber.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: General open plains.

PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.

WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.

WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith's shop at station.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Fitzroy Crossing, 60 miles East.

NEAREST TOWN: Derby, 128 miles West.
