

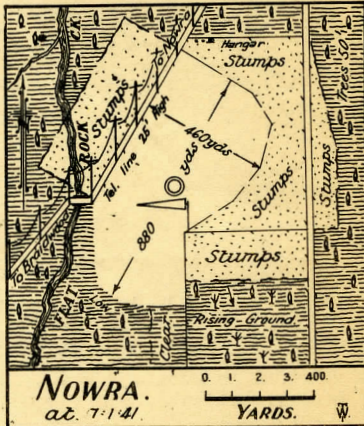
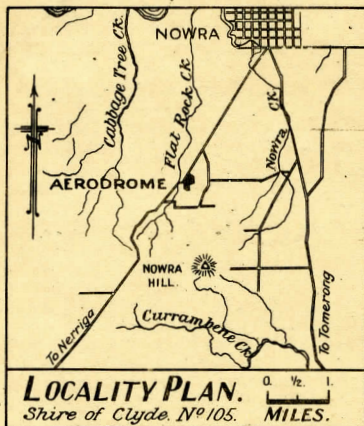

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: $34^{\circ} 55' S$; LONGITUDE: $150^{\circ} 34' E$; MAG. VAR: $9^{\circ} E$ app.
ALTITUDE: 200 feet approx.

POSITION: 3 miles S of Nowra, E of, and adjoining, the Nowra-Braidwood Road. Flat Rock Creek to W.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.9. Stripmap No.43.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: NE-S, hilly timbered country, with some open spaces. W, heavily timbered country.

LANDMARKS: Clearing on the E of the Nowra-Braidwood Road, where road crosses the Flat Rock Creek. Nowra Hill (628') $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles S of aerodrome.

APPROACHES: North - over felled timber. East - over felled timber and road. South - over some timber and clear gap. West - over 15' tel. line; road and timber along creek.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 880 yds. NW-SE, 460 yds.

SURFACE: Heavily grassed.

TOWN: Nowra, 3 miles N.

RAILWAY STATION: Bomaderry, $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.

TELEPHONE: Pound Yard, 1 mile N. (Nowra 53).

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Nowra.

WATER: Pound Yard.

PROPRIETORS: The Nowra Municipal Council.

CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Sheep are grazed on aerodrome.
