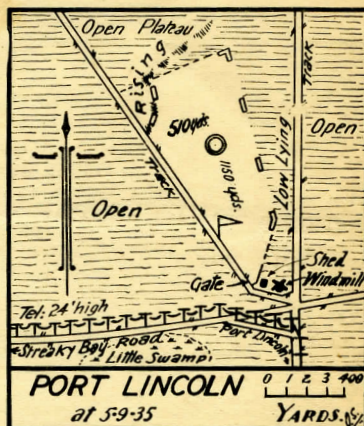

PORT LINCOLN, S.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Licensed for use by all single and light multi-engined aircraft, in dry weather.

PROPRIETORS: The Corporation of the Town of Port Lincoln, P.O. Box 127, Port Lincoln, S.A.

POSITION: At north side of Streaky Bay Road and about 4 miles from Port Lincoln Railway Station.

Lat. $34^{\circ} 40' S$. Long. $135^{\circ} 48' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Roads on three sides; golf links $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south.

MARKINGS: Circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

SURFACE: Reddish soil, rising to twenty feet high on north side; gently falling from north to south.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 1,150 yards.

E. - W. 510 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 200 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Open on three sides. Tel. line, 24 ft. high, windmill and swamp to south.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and open. Railway to west.

PETROL AND OIL: Port Lincoln.

WATER SUPPLY: Well adjacent.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: At house $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to N.W.

TELEGRAPH: Port Lincoln.

RAILWAY STATION: Port Lincoln.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Probably boggy in wet weather.
