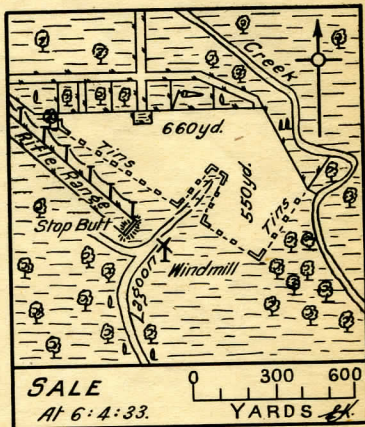
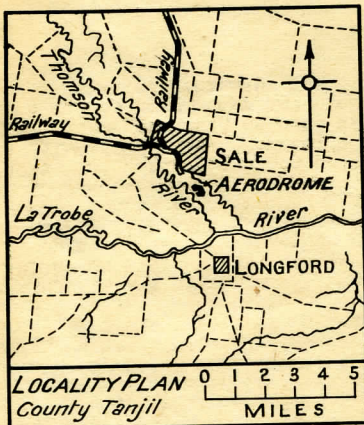

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single-engined land-planes in dry weather only.

PROPRIETORS: Town Council of Sale, Sale, Victoria.

POSITION: About $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Sale, east of Thomson River.
 Lat: $38^{\circ} 7' S$; Long: $147^{\circ} 4' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ approx.

LANDMARKS: Rifle range and river on west and south west.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator and boundary marks.

SURFACE: Level area; southern portion subject to flooding.

DIMENSIONS: N-S: 550 yards; E-W: 660 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 25 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North - few trees and houses; east - isolated trees with thick clump to south east; south and west - generally open but for tel. line on rifle range and a few trees.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open and level.

PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Sale.

WATER SUPPLY: Houses nearby.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Sale Post Office.

NEAREST TOWN AND RAILWAY STATION: Sale.

REMARKS: Southern portion of ground is subject to flooding.
 Rifle range normally in use on Saturdays and on holidays.
 During shooting a red flag flies near stop-but. Beware of ricochets over southern portion of aerodrome.
