

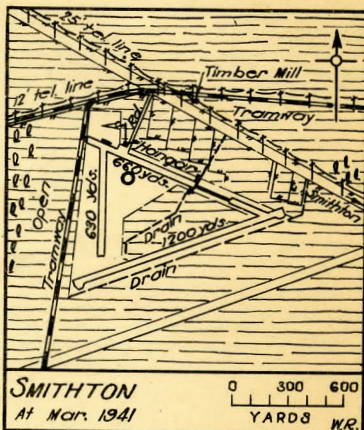
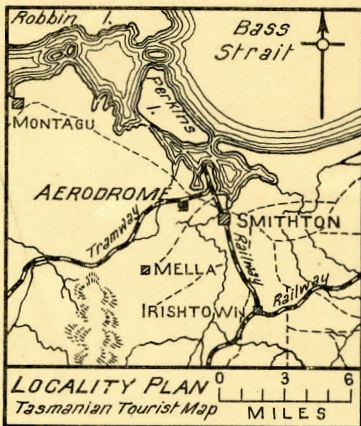

SURFACE: Usable only in dry weather.

CHARGES: When the aircraft is not engaged in joy-riding -
Single-engined aircraft - $2/6$ per day.
