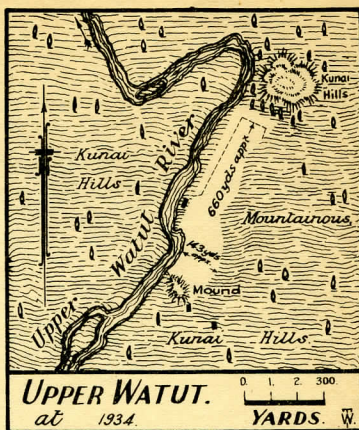
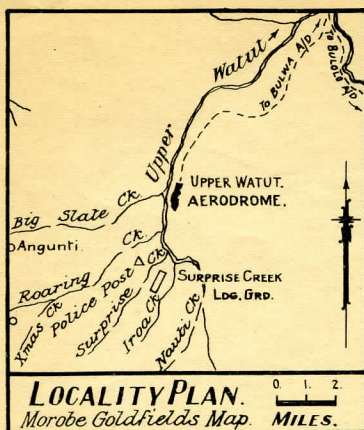


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

UPPER WATUT, N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types, except large multi-engined aircraft.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. H.R. Wales, Cleopatra Lease, Edie Creek, Morobe Goldfield, N.G.

POSITION: On right bank of the Upper Watut River.

Lat.  $7^{\circ}13'S$ . Long.  $146^{\circ}33'E$ .

MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ . approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Upper Watut River on the west, Water race on opposite side of Upper Watut River.

MARKINGS: Nil.

DESCRIPTION: Long narrow ground with slight fall to the north.

DIMENSIONS: N.N.E. - S.S.W. 660 yards, by 143 yards wide (max.)

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2500 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: From south, down Upper Watut River over a mound immediately at south end of ground.

From north, over hills and some timber.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountains covered with "kunai"\* grass.

PETROL AND OIL: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: Upper Watut River.

WORKSHOPS: Nil.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Bulolo Aerodrome (1 day's walk) E.N.E.
