


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 22° 30' S; LONGITUDE: 114° 49' E; MAG. VAR: 1½° W. app.

ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: Situated 2 miles ENE of Yanrey homestead, about 66 miles south of Onslow.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.3. Stripmap No.54.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby, with few small claypans.

LANDMARKS: Homestead 2 miles WSW and Yannarie River about one mile west.

APPROACHES: Scrub 8 ft. high in all directions.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator on south boundary.

DIMENSIONS: NNE-SSW, 660 yds. WNW-ESE, 570 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Onslow, 66 miles north.

TELEPHONE: Yanrey.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Onslow.

REFUELLING: Yanrey.

WATER: Well ½ mile NE.
