

LATITUDE: 15° 10' S; LONGITUDE: 127° 50' E; MAG. VAR. 3° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 100 feet approx.
POSITION: 28 miles NNW of Wyndham and about 3 mile north of

Mission Station buildings. RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet D.5, Stripmaps Nos.28,56. SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough, unsuitable for forced landings. LANDMARKS: Mission Station and Forrest River to south; windmill

about 350 yards SSW of ground. APPROACHES: East, a few scattered trees; elsewhere open. MARKINGS: White circle and corner marks; wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: North-south, 730 yards; east-west, 730 yards.

SURFACE: Generally good, but liable to be boggy after heavy rain.

TOWN and SEAPORT: Wyndham, about 48 miles by launch.

TELEPHONE: Wyndham.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Wyndham.

WATER: Well near windmill, SSW of ground.

PROPRIETORS: Australian Board of Missions (The Superintendent, Forrest River Mission, via Wyndham, W.A.).
