

APPROACHES: N = 25 ft. telegraph lines and timber 30 ft. high; S & E 15ft. telegraph line; W - clear.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator, circle and boundary marks. Name 'CHARIEON' in 6 ft. letters immediately NW of circle.

DESCRIPTION: Prepared area providing runs up to 900 yds. (see sketch). Good firm level surface.
