

Two Killed In Plane Crash

MELBOURNE, Friday.—Leading Aircraftman Douglas Bruce Cowell (19), single, and Leading Aircraftman Douglas Albert Shearer (19), single, were killed in a flying accident near Geelong on Wednesday day.

COWELL was piloting a machine from Point Cook R.A.A.F. station on a training flight when it got out of control, dived into the ground and caught fire. The machine was totally destroyed.

The cause of the accident is obscure.

Both Cowell and Shearer were South Australians. Before enlistment in the R.A.A.F. they had been employed by the Adelaide Electric Supply Company.
