

LATITUDE: 12'S; LONGITUDE: 146° 00'E; MAG.VAR: 7°E approx. ALTITUDE: About 1,200 feet.
POSITION: About 28 miles SW from Tambo, and ½ mile NNW from

Highfields homestead.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G. 8. Stripmaps Nos. 39 and 57.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered with few open patches suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Homestead building SSE. Cattle Creek on western and northern boundaries.

APPROACHES: North and east - open; South and west - over timber to 30 ft. with felled approaches, as shown in sketch.
MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 680 yds; NW-SE, 840 yds; NE-SW, 590 yds. SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Tambo, 28 miles NNE. RAILWAY STATION: Blackall, 92 miles N, Charleville 96 miles S. TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGAR: One small hangar. REPAIRS: At homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supplies at homestead.

WATER: Homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. F.W. Hewson, "Highfields", via Augathella, Qld. CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Claypan portion should be good in all weather.
