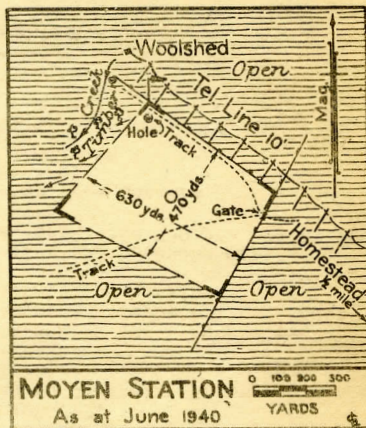
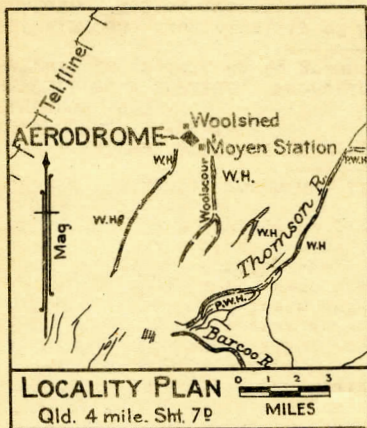

LICENSED AERODROME - "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 25° 05' S; LONGITUDE 142° 54' E; MAG. VAR. 6° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 500 feet approx.

POSITION: 22 miles SSW of Jundah and 4½ miles E of tel. line.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet G.8.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat timbered country with open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Junction of Thomson & Barcoo River 6 miles south.

Moyen Station Homestead ½ mile SE.

APPROACHES: Generally open, except for low tel. line on north and a few trees along creek to west.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 630 yds. NE-SW, 470 yds.

SURFACE: Fairly smooth and level. Not suitable in wet weather.

TOWN: Jundah, 22 miles NNE.

RAILWAY STATION: Yaraka, 120 miles ENE.

TELEPHONE: At homestead ½ mile SE.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Not available.

REFUELLING: Jundah (Try Moyen Station).

WATER: At Woolshed.

PROPRIETORS: N.P. Saywell, "Moyen", Jundah, Qld.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots are warned of an excavation in the northern corner.
