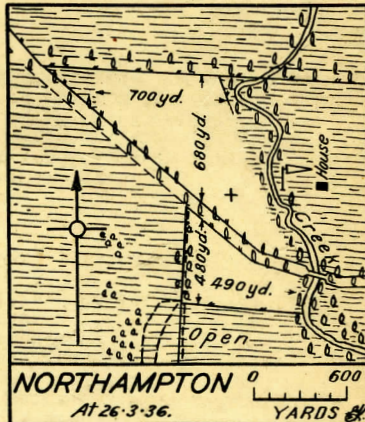
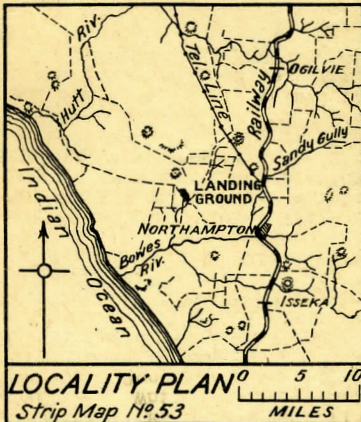


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NORTHAMPTON, W.A.



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Emergency landing ground.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.  
**POSITION:** About 8 miles north-west of Northampton.  
 Lat.:  $28^{\circ} 19'$  S. Long:  $114^{\circ} 32'$  E.  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West approx.  
**LANDMARKS:** Creek and homestead to east.  
**MARKINGS:** White cross and wind indicator.  
**SURFACE:** Fair.  
**DIMENSIONS:** Northern area: 700 yards by 680 yards.  
 Southern area: 490 yards by 480 yards.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 100 ft. approx.  
**APPROACHES:** Northern area: N., S., and W., trees 20 feet high  
 along roads; E., trees along creek. Southern area: N., trees  
 20 feet high along road; E. & W., trees on boundaries;  
 S., clear.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Generally flat and cultivated.  
**PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS:** Northampton, 8 miles south-east.  
**WATER SUPPLY:** Homestead adjacent.  
**TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH:** Northampton.  
**NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION:** Northampton.  
**CHARGES:** Nil.  
**REMARKS:** The two areas are cropped alternately, and the ground  
 mark is placed on the area on which pilots should land. The  
 Department has no legal tenure, but the owners have given  
 permission for the ground to be used as an E.L.G.  
 Relative Stripmap No. 53.
