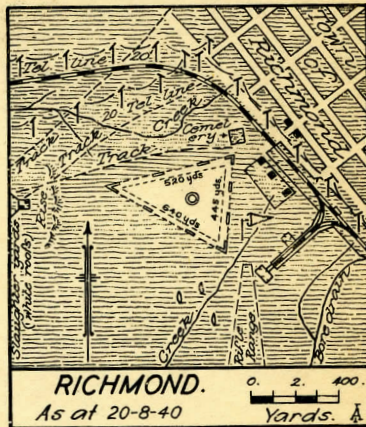


DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.500

LICENSED AERODROME - "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: $20^{\circ} 43' S$; LONGITUDE: $143^{\circ} 08' E$; MAG. VAR: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. app.
 ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.

POSITION: $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west of Richmond Township and Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet F.8.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Clear and slightly undulating. Suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Township and railway adjacent.

APPROACHES: N - over Railway and 20' tell. line. E - over township and railway yards. W - over building. S - clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary mark and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 640 yds. E-W, 520 yds. N-S, 445 yds.

SURFACE: Graded strips good. Liable to be soft after rain.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Richmond $\frac{1}{4}$ mile E.

TELEPHONE: Richmond.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Richmond.

WATER: Houses nearby.

PROPRIETORS: Wyangarie Shire Council, P.O. Box No.18, Richmond, Q.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots are warned that this aerodrome is licensed for dry weather only.
