While engaged in a training flight at Laverton on Friday, Flight-officer H. E. Sharp of Point Cook, was injured when the Moth aeroplane in which he was flying crashed from a height of several hundred feet.

The aeroplane was badly damaged, and Mr. Sharp received injuries to the head. The Air Accident Enquiry Board will make an investigation when Mr. Sharp leaves the Caulfield Military Hospital.
