This aircraft served in the R.A.A.F. until the mid 1970's when it was given to the P.N.G.D.F. as overseas aid.

The aeroplane was purchased and then flown to Moree by the Proprietor of the Amaroo Tavern, Mr. Marty Taylor. The interior is configured for military transport as used for the Papua New Guinea Defence Force. Sit in the Captain's seat and imagine flying the aircraft during World War II. Have your photo taken to preserve your memories.
