LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 28° 52' S. LONGITUDE: 153° 34' E. MAG. VAR: 9° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 4 feet approx.

POSITION: On peninsula immediately east of Ballina.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet H.9. Stripmap No.2.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hills to west and north. Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: River on SE and NE. Houses on west. River mouth 1 mile east. Road bridge ENE.

APPROACHES: West - houses, wireless masts (45' high) and tel. lines. NE - electric light line on bridge approach near wind indicator. All other directions clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks, and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 750 yards. NW-SE, 390 yards.

SURFACE: Good level surface of firm sandy nature. Should be good in all weathers.

TOWN: Ballina.

RAILWAY STATION: Ballina.

TELEPHONE: Houses adjacent.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING & REPAIRS: Ballina.

WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: Ballina Municipal Council.

CHARGES: 2/6 per landing, or 10/- per day.

REMARKS: "C" Class license for favourable winds only.
