


OBSTRUCTIONS TO AIRCRAFT: 2 BE Bega, N.S.W. -  
Broadcasting Station 2 BE, 1½ miles S.E. of Bega Post Office,  
will be indicated at night by a light on top of the adjoining  
station building. Obstruction light is 123' below the top  
of the masts, the distance from the rear mast to this  
building being 150' and bearing 35° true. Approx. 318°  
from Bega Post Office.
