DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.512 NARRABRI, N.S.W.

(REVISED - JANUARY, 1941)

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 30° 18½ S; LONGITUDE: 149° 50' E; MAG. VAR: 9° E app.

ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.

POSITION: 3 miles NE of town of Narrabri.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat, with timbered patches. Generally suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Narrabri, 3 miles SW of landing ground. Horse Arm Creek ½ mile NW and windmill near SE corner.

APPROACHES: North - over 30 ft. tel. line, low ridge and 50 ft. timber. South - over timber. West - over small scattered trees. East - open. Timber has been felled on SW approach.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 880 yards. SW-NE, 460 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Narrabri, 3 miles SW.

TELEPHONE: Narrabri.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Narrabri.

WATER: At nearby house.

PROPRIETORS: Municipality of Narrabri.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots should avoid landing or taking off over high ground opposite the middle of the N boundary.
