


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of land-planes, such as D.H. Moth, Avro Avian, etc.

PROPRIETOR: William Green, Perth Road, Albany, W.A.

POSITION: $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Albany.

Lat. $34^{\circ} 59\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $117^{\circ} 51'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 5° W. approx.

LANDMARKS: Perth-Albany Road on the east, Lake McKail to the N.W.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Fair, inclined to be soft when wet.

DIMENSIONS: N - S 440 yds. E - W 390 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 200 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Over clearing east and west; timber north and south.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly, timbered and unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Albany, $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles by gravel road.

WATER SUPPLY: On ground.

WORKSHOPS: Albany.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Telephone at house $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north of ground.

NEAREST TOWN AND PORT: Albany.

RAILWAY STATION: Albany.

CHARGES: 2/6d per landing.

REMARKS: Strip map No. 34.
