

LATITUDE: 36°04' S. LONGITUDE: 146°57' E. MAG.VAR: 8½° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 540 feet approx.
POSITION: About 2 miles NE of Albury, between railway line and Sydney Highway.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.8. Stripmaps Nos.4 and 11.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat with some cleared areas suitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: Town of Albury, racecourse, Sydney Highway and railway line.
APPROACHES: North - over racecourse and trees to 40 feet high. South - over lopped trees and tel. line 20 feet high. East - over lopped trees and orchard 20 feet high. West - over lopped trees.
MARKINGS: Wind indicators and gravel runways.
DIMENSIONS: Runs up to 1,000 yards. Three runways each 700 yards long (see sketch).
SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Albury, 2 miles SW.
TELEPHONE: Half mile south, at Waterworks (Albury No.124).
HANGARS: Nil.
REFUELLING & REPAIRS: Albury.
WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: Albury Council, Albury, N.S.W.
CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Emergency night landing facilities available. Aircraft requiring to make a forced landing during the hours of darkness should circle the town or aerodrome three times and either fire Verey lights or signal by flash lamp or other means.
