



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

ALEXISHAFEN, N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single-engined land-planes.

PROPRIETORS: Catholic Mission of the Holy Ghost.

POSITION: About 2 miles west of the Mission station, and on the left bank of the Murrain River.

Lat. $5^{\circ}5\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $144^{\circ}48'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 5° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Alexishafen to east, Mission station 2 miles east, Murrain River to south and east. Clearing in coconut palms (20 to 30 ft. high).

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Gravelled surface (sand covered), firm in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W. \circ 590 metres.

N.W. - S.E. 465 metres.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 100 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: From west, over coconut palms to 30 ft. high, then cleared for 180 metres; from north-west over small bush covered hills and then cleared for 240 metres.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Coconut plantations.

PETROL AND OIL: Limited supply at Mission station, otherwise at Madang about 10 miles south.

WATER SUPPLY: At aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Nil.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: For Mission aeroplane only.

TELEPHONE: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Madang radio.

NEAREST TOWN: Madang, 10 miles south.

NEAREST PORT: Alexishafen, 2 miles east.

CHARGES: Nil
