


LATITUDE: $18^{\circ}01'$ S. LONGITUDE: $135^{\circ}32\frac{1}{2}'$ E. MAG.VAR: $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.approx,
ALTITUDE: 800 feet approx.

POSITION: Approx. $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles SSE of Anthony Lagoon Police Station,
on Anthony Lagoon - Brunette Downs Stock Route.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.6. Stripmap No.6.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open plains, suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Homestead, Police Station and store buildings to NNW.
APPROACHES: Ground surrounded by timber which has been felled
10 chains back as shown on sketch.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator. "A Lagoon" painted on roof of build-
ings $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles NNW.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 1100 yards; NNE-SSW, 850 yards;
NNW-SSE, 850 yards.

SURFACE: Good - red soil.

TOWN: Camooweal, 230 miles south-east.

RAILWAY STATION: Birdum, 450 miles north-west.

TELEPHONE: Wireless at Police Station.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Refuelling at Anthony Lagoon Homestead $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles NNW.

WATER: Anthony Lagoon Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots are warned against anthills and suckers
in the wet season.
