


CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
POSITION: About $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Brisbane-Charleville railway line, about 15 miles east of Charleville.
Lat: $26^{\circ} 24' S$; Long: $146^{\circ} 28' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $7^{\circ} E$. approx.
LANDMARKS: T shaped clearing in timber. Homestead adjacent.
Railway station about 2 miles south-west.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Sand and gravel; good in all weathers. Ground falls slightly from west to east.
DIMENSIONS: NW-SE: 570 yards; E-W: 530 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,200 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions; felled at ends of NW, SE and W approaches.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally unsuitable for forced landings.
PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Charleville, about 15 miles west.
WATER SUPPLY: At homestead adjoining.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: Homestead adjoining.
TELEGRAPH: Charleville Post Office.
NEAREST TOWN: Charleville.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Arabella siding, about 2 miles SW.
CHARGES: Nil at present.
REMARKS: Stripmap No.3.
