

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.  
PROPRIETORS: Administration of the Territory of New Guinea.  
POSITION: Between Pulie River and Cape Merkus on south west coast of New Britain.  
Lat:  $6^{\circ} 9\frac{1}{2}'$  S; Long:  $149^{\circ} 9'$  E.  
MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $6^{\circ}$  E approx.  
LANDMARKS: Sea to south east; plantation about 7 miles south west. Pulie River about 7 miles north east.  
MARKINGS: Nil.  
DIMENSIONS: NW-SE: 600 yards. Width 60 yards.  
Single landing strip falling towards north west.  
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 230 ft. approx.  
APPROACHES: Landings should be made from north west end only.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Sea to south east; otherwise bush.  
PETROL & OIL: Limited supply at plantation about 7 miles south west by good road.  
WORKSHOPS: Plantation about 7 miles south west.  
WATER SUPPLY: Anglican Mission Station adjoining.  
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Information not available.  
NEAREST EUROPEAN SETTLEMENT: Anglican Mission Station adjoining.  
CHARGES: Nil at present.  
REMARKS: Landings should be made from north west only.
