


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 44/1929.

ARGYLE DOWNS, W.A.



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Emergency Landing Ground.

**PROPRIETORS:** Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

**POSITION:** Lat.  $16^{\circ}18'S$ . Long.  $128^{\circ}47'E$ . About  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles S.E. of homestead.

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:** About  $3^{\circ}E$ .

**DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:** Mt. Misery, 2 miles to North, and Behn River to East.

**MARKINGS:** White cross and wind indicator.

**DESCRIPTION:** Very irregular shape, good surface; should be firm in all weathers. Portion of Western runway may be soft in wet weather.

**DIMENSIONS:** N. - S. 620 yards.

E. - W. 400 yards.

N.W.-S.E. 520 yards.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 500 feet.

**APPROACHES:** Over low timber in all directions.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Timbered, with several open flats.

**PETROL AND OIL:** At homestead,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles to North.

**WATER SUPPLY:** At homestead.

**WORKSHOPS:** Blacksmiths' tools at station and Wyndham Meat Works, roughly 100 miles.

**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Nil.

**TELEPHONE:** Nil.

**TELEGRAPH:** Nil.

**NEAREST TOWN:** Wyndham, roughly 100 miles.

**REMARKS:** Relative Strip Map No. 56.
