



DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.314 ATHERTON, QLD.

(REVISED - OCTOBER, 1940)

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 17°15' S. LONGITUDE: 145°30' E. MAG.VAR: 6° E. approx.

ALTITUDE: 2450 feet approx.

POSITION: 2½ miles ENE of Atherton.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.8. Stripmap No.41.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open and cultivated.

LANDMARKS: "L" shaped ground. Farm buildings to south as per sketch.

APPROACHES: Open in all directions, except for telephone line, 30 feet high, along road to south.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator - ground surrounded by fence.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 540 yds. E-W, 725 yds. Graded strip 800 yds.

SURFACE: Good and usable in all weathers.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Atherton, 2¼ miles WSW.

TELEPHONE: At nearby farm house.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Atherton.

WATER: At farm house.

PROPRIETORS: Atherton Shire Council, Atherton, Nth. Queensland.

CHARGES: 1-2 seater 2/6 per landing, 10/- per day.
