



DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.417

AYR, QLD.

(REVISED - JANUARY, 1941.)

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS

LATITUDE: $19^{\circ} 33\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $147^{\circ} 23'$ E. MAG. VAR: 6° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 24 feet approx.

POSITION: Approx. 1 mile north-west of Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet E.8. Stripmaps Nos. 62, 63 and 66.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Few trees, but generally suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Railway, main road, cemetery and several buildings, (see sketch).

APPROACHES: Railway and tel. lines to south; 30 ft. trees and windmill to south-east; few trees west.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 700 yds; N-S, 660 yds.

SURFACE: Good for all weather. Portion of north end is liable to become soft after heavy rain.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Ayr, 1 mile south-east.

TELEPHONE: Ayr Post Office.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING & REPAIRS: Ayr.

WATER: Adjacent houses.

PROPRIETORS: Ayr Shire Council, P.O. Box 593, Ayr, N. Qld.

CHARGES: 1-2 seater planes, 2/6 per landing, 10/- per day.
