

LATITUDE: 32°06' S. LONGITUDE: 141°47' E. MAG. VAR: 6° E. approx.
ALTITUDE: 300 ft. approx.

POSITION: Adjacent and N of Broken Hill-Menindee Road, 22 miles SE of Broken Hill.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.7. Stripmaps Nos. 32, 52 and 70.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low scrub and saltbush; suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Main Broken Hill-Menindee Road to S. Dam near SW boundary.

APPROACHES: Clear in all directions.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 610 yards; E-W, 720 yards.

SURFACE: Fair - good.

TOWN: Broken Hill, 22 miles NW.

RAILWAY STATION: Warratta, 8 miles N.

TELEPHONE: Warratta.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Broken Hill.

WATER: Dam to SW of ground.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
